**Kota Kinabalu, Sabah, 15 May 2015** - Parkway Pantai today commemorated the soft opening of Gleneagles Kota Kinabalu Hospital (GKK), its 13<sup>th</sup> hospital in Malaysia which is also Sabah's first international standard hospital.

GKK marks Parkway Pantai's first foray into East Malaysia.
