Hospital marks silver jubilee with gala bash

KUALA LUMPUR, 13 January – More than 300 guests attended Pantai Hospital Cheras' silver jubilee gala dinner yesterday to celebrate the medical milestones that constitute its 25-year history.

Pantai Hospital Cheras opened its doors in 1994 with less than 50 personnel, 12 consultants, and a focus mainly on obstetrics and gynaecology. Today, it commands a 350-strong workforce of around 70 consultants specialising in various disciplines including general surgery, neurosurgery, ophthalmology, orthopaedics, otorhinolaryngology, paediatrics, and orthopaedics.

To commemorate the occasion, the hospital announced a comprehensive health screening package for senior citizens priced at RM25. Originally valued at RM250, the tests encompass checks for diabetes, nose cancer, and liver function. It is open to residents of Cheras aged 60 years and above, and valid for the first 500 participants who register by 30th June 2019.

Rachel Yew, Chief Executive Officer of Pantai Hospital Cheras, reiterated the organisation's vision and commitment to delivering best in class health services and outcomes to the Cheras community.

"Our doctors, nurses, allied health professionals, and administrative team have worked hard to live up to Pantai's brand promise, which is to serve, heal, and deliver," she commented in her welcome address.
