**Gleneagles Hong Kong Hospital opens its doors today  
Bringing best-in-class healthcare services and patient experience to Hong Kong people**

(21 March 2017 – Hong Kong) Gleneagles Hong Kong Hospital (GHK), a 500-bed multi-specialty private tertiary hospital located in Wong Chuk Hang in Hong Kong Island South, goes into operation today to serve Hong Kong people with best-in-class healthcare services and patient experience. GHK is a joint venture between Parkway Pantai and NWS Holdings Limited, with Li Ka Shing Faculty of Medicine of The University of Hong Kong (HKU) as its exclusive clinical partner.

**Comprehensive range of services**

GHK provides a wide range of clinical services spanning more than 35 specialties and subspecialties. In addition to inpatient services, GHK's specialist outpatient services span 16 specialties through 14 clinics, including General Surgery, General Medicine, Orthopaedic Surgery, ENT /Eye, Urology, Paediatric, Chinese Medicine and Health Screening etc. Other service centres include Endoscopy Centre, Rehabilitation Centre, Cardiovascular Laboratory, Chemotherapy Centre and Dialysis Centre. GHK also provides Accident and Emergency services (A&E) which are provided by A&E specialists and medical professionals trained to provide prompt and appropriate treatments to patients with urgent medical conditions.

**State-of-the-art medical equipment and facilities**

As a brand-new hospital, GHK has the advantage of being one of the most modern and well-equipped hospitals in Hong Kong, providing state-of-the-art equipment and facilities including PET CT, nuclear medicine facilities, 24-hour fully-automated core laboratory system, Critical Care Unit and operating theatres capable of conducting complex surgeries. GHK is one of the first private hospital in Hong Kong to use the fully-automated track system that handles routine blood tests and chemistry tests. GHK is also one of the first private hospitals in Hong Kong to use the automated, decentralised medication dispensing system that ensures efficient and accurate drug management and dispensing. Other advanced equipment in the pipeline include the Linear Accelerator and Radiosurgery and PET MRI.

Dr Tan See Leng, Group Chief Executive Officer and Managing Director of Parkway Pantai, says, "The opening of Gleneagles Hong Kong Hospital (GHK) is an important milestone of the Group as it marks our first tertiary healthcare facility in Hong Kong. In addition to delivering excellent clinical outcomes, we believe that giving our patients peace of mind through a transparent fee structure will position GHK

as a unique patient-centric hospital. Drawing on the expertise of Parkway Pantai, NWS Holdings and Li Ka Shing Faculty of Medicine of The University of Hong Kong, we are committed to offering best-in-class healthcare services and patient care to the people of Hong Kong.”

Mr Tsang Yam Pui, Chief Executive Officer of NWS Holdings Limited, says, “Completing a project of this scale, starting from construction to bringing it to operational level, is a demonstration of professionalism, expertise and teamwork. Gleneagles Hong Kong Hospital (GHK) is a hospital for Hong Kong people as 70% of the bed days will be set aside for Hong Kong residents. We also take pride in being a private teaching hospital to train doctors, nurses and allied healthcare professionals, contributing to the development of HK’s healthcare industry and advancement of clinical research.”

Professor Gabriel Leung, Dean of Medicine, HKU, says, "As a new member of HKU Health System, GHK is our first full-scale private sector experiment in partnership with a global health care conglomerate. We shall make use of our expertise to apply standardization of best clinical governance practice in GHK. With the engagement in direct service provision at GHK, we could expand our patient base thereby providing opportunities for high quality clinical research in a wider spectrum of diseases and clinical conditions."

### **All-inclusive and fixed-price medical packages**

GHK is the first private hospital in Hong Kong to provide at least 51% of inpatient bed days at packaged rates. At the initial stage, 54 medical packages will be provided. All packages are fixed-price and all-inclusive in nature, covering complications required, including re-operation and ICU care, within the prescribed length of stay. Fee advisory services will be offered to all patients before admission to help patients better manage costs and make informed decisions.

### **High patient comfort and privacy with warm and healing ambience**

GHK places great emphasis on patients’ comfort and privacy. It offers a selection of inpatient room types, ranging from its 2-bedded standard rooms to single rooms and suites, to meet different patients’ needs and preferences. This is complemented by thoughtful interior designs that create a warm, healing ambience throughout the hospital.

Comprising two towers with nine levels, the design and layout of GHK facilitates efficient operation and patient flows with clear zoning of key services. Landscape gardens are located on the Third floor and Fifth floor, providing patients with a peaceful, green, outdoor environment during their stay. These gardens, together with a footbridge on the Sixth Floor, connect the two towers.
